

# Regulatory Update

## Notification required for R&TT equipment operating in non-harmonized frequency bands - Croatia

Following PCS regulatory update in March, where we advised that products meeting the requirements of the R&TTE Directive in Europe can be placed on the Market in Croatia without any further type approval activity, further information has been issued regarding products operating in non harmonised bands:

*In the case of R&TT equipment using frequency bands which are not European harmonised frequency bands for such R&TT equipment, or which is not in accordance with the Ordinance on the radio-frequency spectrum allocation, the manufacturer or his authorised representative or the person responsible for placing such equipment on the market in the Republic of Croatia must submit official notification at least 30 days before placing the equipment on the market.*

*If the R&TT equipment listed in the notification is not in accordance with the Radio Frequency Allocation Table or there are other prescribed limitations of use of such equipment in the Republic of Croatia, HAKOM shall inform the person who submitted the notification about that within 30 days of the receipt of the notification.*
