Regulatory Alert

New Energy Efficiency requirements in Belarus – to be postponed and to be implemented together with new Energy Labelling requirements

Further to PCS' Regulatory Alert dated 20th December 2016, regarding the implementation date of the new Energy Efficiency (EE) regulation, it has since been advised that certain changes have been introduced to # 849 Resolution of the Belarus Council of Ministers of 21st October 2016 with respect to the dates of implementation of the EE regulation.

The implementation date for the EE regulation will now come into force for the following products on the list of products subject to mandatory national conformity assessment as follows:

From **1st September 2017**, the following equipment and which are imported under the corresponding HS codes will require Energy Efficiency Approval:

Household electrical appliances of AC power supply:	HS Codes

While it was originally planned to offer a transitional period of 6 months from implementation date for manufacturers to fulfill Energy Labelling (EL) requirements, it is now envisaged that the EE regulation and EL requirements will come into force simultaneously.

Please note that the official government decision is expected to be signed within coming weeks, after which PCS will advise accordingly.

PCS will continue to monitor this change, and will keep customers updated once more information becomes available.
