

# Regulatory Alert - Chile

## Multi-band stamp mandatory on mobile phones packaging

Further to PCS' Regulatory Alert dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2016 concerning new requirements for packaging of mobile phones, the Chilean Regulator, *Subsecretaría de Telecomunicaciones* (SUBTEL), announced the implementation of this new regulation on 13<sup>th</sup> March.

With this new regulation, mobile phones containing 2G, 3G or 4G technology are required to display a multi-band stamp on the front of the box/packaging of the device, in order to show the cellular technologies supported. As a reminder, please see below examples of each stamp:



*Device supports 2G, 3G and 4G technologies.*



*Device supports 2G and 3G technologies only.*



*Device supports 3G and 4G technologies only.*



*Device supports 2G technology only.*



*Device supports 3G technology only.*



*Device supports 4G technology only.*



PCS also understands that it will be mandatory for mobile phones to operate in all permitted frequency bands of at least one cellular technology (2G, 3G or 4G) supported.
