India – Proposed BIS Safety Approval Scheme Expansion – Phase III

Electronics and Information Technology Goods (Requirements for Compulsory Registration) Order, 2012

The Department of Electronics and Information Technology (Deity) in India is deliberating a proposed expansion to the scope of (to include new products to) the Electronics and Information Technology Goods (Requirements for Compulsory Registration) Order, 2012.

It is understood that BIS is currently in internal discussions on this proposed expansion and is yet to publish the final list of new products and confirm the final date of implementation.

The only change of this proposal to the BIS registration system is the increased scope of product types that the scheme applies to. The processes and procedures of BIS registration have not been changed.

PCS is closely monitoring the situation and will provide further updates in due course.

11. CCTV Cameras/Equipment for CCTV Cameras
12. Adapters for household and similar appliances
