Introduction of EMI Testing at Indonesian lab

The Indonesian Regulator lab, Direktorat Jenderal Sumber Daya dan Perangkat Pos dan Informatika (SDPPI), has now formally announced that all products which are AC powered i.e. products directly connected to the mains power and not via a DC adapter must now undergo Conducted Electromagnetic Interference (EMI) test.

It is expected that fees will increase as a result of the extra tests that will be performed, although exact fees have not yet been confirmed. It is also understood that the EMI testing will be performed to CISPR standard.
