

# Regulatory Update

## Argentina – updated regulations for 5GHz WLAN, Bluetooth, and UHF RFID devices

### WLAN

**5600 – 5650MHz frequency range must be disabled for all WLAN devices from 4<sup>th</sup> November 2013**

- As of 4<sup>th</sup> November, manufacturers will have to disable the 5600 - 5650MHz portion of 5GHz Band 3 (channels 120, 124 and 128) for all WLAN devices.
- All current Approvals remain valid until their expiry
- At renewal, manufacturers must submit a declaration confirming that the band has been disabled

### Bluetooth and UHF RFID

Despite the release of updated regulation, “*Protocolo de equipos de espectro ensanchado por salto en frecuencia*”, it has been re-confirmed that no retesting will be required for any devices tested to previous CNC standard “*CNC Q2 63.01*”
