Mongolia – new Approval procedure established

Following PCS Regulatory Update in April 2013 the Mongolian Regulator, Communications Regulatory Commission (CRC), has now established their new conformity assessment procedure regarding Type Approval of radio and telecommunications equipment.

Following the release of this new procedure, the following changes have been implemented:

- Samples are no longer required for local testing or inspection and a paper-work only process can be followed however the Authority reserve the right to request a sample if the documentation and test reports provided are not deemed sufficient.
- Certificate validity will be determined by product type rather than a set time-frame.
- It is now mandatory that the local importer or distributor of the product act as the Approval holder
- Certificates can be valid for a period of up to 3 years but validity is dependent on product type.

Moving forward, all products being imported into Mongolia must now apply for Type Approval under this new procedure. Any applications placed on hold earlier this year must now also follow the new procedure. However, this does not apply to certificates that are still valid.

Official regulations confirming all changes are due to be published shortly, more details will follow accordingly.
