

# Regulatory Update

Swaziland - SCom is now official Telecommunications Regulator

Following the introduction of Swaziland Communications Commission (SCom) last year, it has been confirmed that all regulatory functions and power have officially been handed over to SCom.

The former regulator, Swaziland Posts and Telecommunications Corporation (SPTC), has remained as support for SCom during this transition period and all Type Approval applications submitted to SPTC have automatically been transferred to SCom.

As a result of these changes, previous requirements for Type Approval applications which were not enforced by SPTC are now being requested for all applications:

For all devices submitted for Approval, one of the below must be submitted:

- i) One representative sample\*
- ii) A copy of the Approval Certificate from ICASA

\*For large equipment where it is not feasible to ship samples, full TCF (including BOM, schematics and layout diagrams) must be provided instead.

During this transition period, delays are expected for all applications currently under review.
