India – BIS Safety Approval Scheme – Labelling Requirements

Electronics and Information Technology Goods (Requirements for Compulsory Registration) Order, 2012.

On 1st December 2015, the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) in India issued gazette notification S.O. 3240(E) whereby a new label option, the *Standard Mark*, for registered devices was introduced in order to simplify the labelling requirements.

With effect from 1st December 2015, manufacturers have the option of applying either of the below label option to their BIS registered devices:

- a) The current self declaration statement - “*Self Declaration - Conforming to IS XXXXX, R-XXXXXXXX*”
- b) The newly-introduced Standard Mark

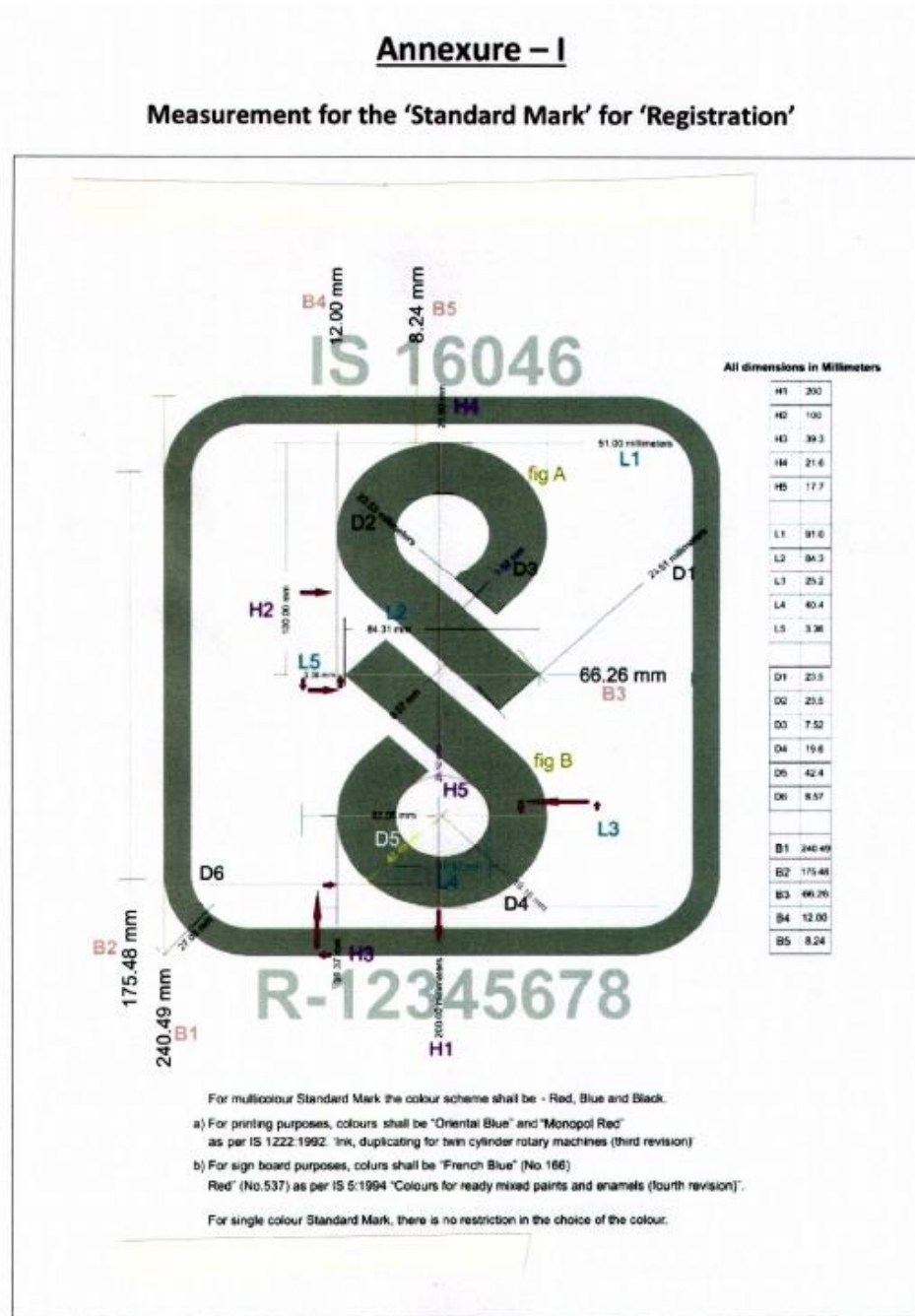
For both the Standard Mark and the Self Declaration statement, the IS and Registration numbers and words shall be no less than Arial font size 6. In addition, the 'Standard Mark' can be displayed in single colour or multiple colour.
