Philippines – Multiple Gigabit Wireless Systems (MGWS) in frequencies around 60 GHz were allocated

In January, 2016, the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) issued a memorandum circular for the implementation and operation of the Multiple Gigabit Wireless Systems (MGWS) including RLAN devices around the 60 GHz frequency range.

The frequency band 57-66 GHz is allocated with channel bandwidth of 2160 MHz. The MGWS standards shall employ the same channelization in order to promote better co-existence and the following center frequencies are recommended:

58.32 GHz

60.48 GHz

62.64 GHz

64.80 GHz

Only type approved/accepted MGWS devices with an integral antenna installed and with no external antenna socket for connecting an external antenna shall be allowed.
