

Regulatory Alert – Argentina

Issuance of updated Resolution on Low Power Devices

On 26th February 2016, ENACOM (Ente Nacional de Comunicaciones) issued Resolution N° 15/2016 replacing previous Resolution N° 86/2014, concerning Low power devices.

The most significant changes cover:

24.5GHz to 25.80GHz frequency range for Ultra-Wide Band (UWB) has now been allocated for the use of Vehicular radars.

Furthermore, requirements of non-desired emission for equipment containing 13.56MHz (RFID technology) have been modified from < 913 μ V/m to <334 μ V/m.

ENACOM have confirmed to PCS, Resolution N° 15/2016 will be effective once a relevant updated technical standard is published for which the timeframe still remains unconfirmed. Details regarding any necessary retesting or change of process to follow for certification can only be identified upon publication of the technical standard.

PCS is monitoring the situation closely and will provide further updates in due course.
