

Regulatory Alert - Mexico

Public consultation on possible changes to National Frequency Allocation Plan underway

Mexican Regulator *Instituto Federal de Telecomunicaciones* (IFT) have released a statement on their website advising a public consultation is underway concerning possible modifications to their National Frequency Allocation Plan.

The main objectives of this public consultation are:

- i. to establish the basis for updating the National Frequency Allocation Table.*
- ii. to express changes resulting from modifications to the ITU Radio Regulations.*
- iii. to provide an efficient consultation tool for radio communication services to which particular radio spectrum frequency bands are allocated, as well as additional information on the use and planning of radio frequency spectrum services.*

The public consultation officially opened on 11th November and will close on 9th December. Any interested parties can register their comments, opinions or suggestions up until this date at the following webpage:
