

# Regulatory Update - Indonesia

14<sup>th</sup> December 2016

## **Paperwork Only Type Approval Process expected to be introduced in 2017**

The Indonesian Regulator, Direktorat Jenderal Sumber Daya dan Perangkat Pos dan Informatika (SDPPI), has advised that a new policy is being considered whereby a paperwork only Type Approval process will be permitted. This new policy is expected to run in parallel with the standard Type Approval process already in place and whereby local testing is conducted.

Manufacturers will therefore have the option to proceed via either a paperwork only process, or via local testing.

This new policy has not yet been published or released, but is expected to come into force in 2017.

PCS will continue to monitor this closely and will keep customers updated as soon as further updates are available.
