

Regulatory Update - Indonesia

Announcement of Submission of New Applications via a New Online System

The Indonesian Regulator, Direktorat Jenderal Sumber Daya dan Perangkat Pos dan Informatika (SDPPI), has just announced that from 4th September 2017, all applications will be submitted online without the need for hardcopy submission.

As part of this new online system, all existing manufacturers registered with SDPPI are required to re-register before 4th September 2017. Manufacturers only have until 31st August 2017 to complete this re-registration, since Friday 1st September 2017 is a national holiday in Indonesia.

Existing manufacturers that do not re-register before 4th September 2017 will have their registration cancelled and will be unable to submit new Type Approval Applications until they newly apply for registration, which could take a longer period to complete.

To re-register, manufacturers are required to provide the following information to SDPPI;

- Manufacturer name
- Manufacturer address
- Name of contact person
- Email address of the contact person showing company's domain
- Telephone number of contact person
