

QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE FOR THE REGULATION 2016/425 ON PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AS BROUGHT INTO UK LAW AND AMENDED (RX110)



1 INTRODUCTION

This document is a quick reference guide indicating the documents to be submitted by an applicant to obtain a UKCA-type Examination Certificate (Module B) for the PPE Regulations.

An application must consist of at least the information as listed in the “Subject” column. Where applicable a document number is given to help the applicant.

Application information may be submitted in the following formats: PDF / JPEG Image / Microsoft Excel or in Microsoft Word. Files submitted in Acrobat PDF format are preferred. In case the files are in a different format than listed above please contact Kiwa Ltd. Documents should be sent in one file per document type e.g. five internal photos in 1 file.
